OUR ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate and Postgraduate

To join our Study Abroad programme we require:

- You to be in good academic standing at your home university, or a strong academic background in High School if you're choosing our Gap Year Option
- You to have met any pre-requisites for the modules you choose at Essex
- For Gap Year applicants, we will need a letter of recommendation from your High School or a recent employer

Our English language requirements:

- IELTS 6.0 or
- TOEFL iBT 76

We are able to accept other forms of proof of English language, so please just get in touch if you have any questions around this.

Pre-Sessional English programmes

We offer a wide range of pre-sessional English language courses over the summer. Our pre-sessional courses are available to you if you hold an offer from us. These can enable you to raise your IELTS score by 0.5, 1.0 and 1.5. If you meet our language requirements already, there's an optional 4 week pre-sessional course to prepare you for your studies with us.
